Auction Rules:

1. Bids are accepted till 5 p.m. on the closing date, but no later.
2. This is an auction by mail. However, phone bids will be accepted. We do not reveal the high bid to anyone unless the bidder clearly indicates he or she is finished bidding, or has become the highest bidder. This maintains an auction quality to our sales, in our opinion.
3. Bids below 60% of our estimates are not accepted. Some lots have reserves of up to 90% of the estimate.
4. Bids are reduced to 10% above the second highest bid. Regularly an eager bidder receives a lot for say \$22.00 (10% above 2nd highest bid of \$20.00) on a bid of \$100.00.
5. Our descriptive word grading is very accurate, almost as good as a photograph.
6. NEW BIDDERS will be invoiced for successful bids, and the lots will be shipped following payment. Checks must clear. A money order or other immediately negotiable instrument will facilitate shipment as soon as it is received.

Flattening is also a factor to consider in making your bid. Conversely, a VF coin with absolutely no deductions is a most unusual coin in almost anyone's sale, and usually commands a premium bid.
