

Submission guidelines for COS 426 assignments

Or how to let your TAs let you enjoy your life

Remove unnecessary files

- MSVC
 - Clean Solution
 - Remove all Debug and Release directories in src and subdirectories
 - Remove all ipch directories
 - Remove .sdf file in the src directory
- Linux and Mac - terminal
 - cd src
 - make clean
 - cd ../..
 - rm -r __MACOSX (only some people have it)

Naming and directory tree

- Rename the root directory of your submission:
 - NetID_cos426_assignmentX
 - Where X – respective assignment number
 - NetID – your NetID
- Your root directory should contain:
 - src, input, output, and art directories
 - All Makefiles necessary to build your code and get your results
 - Your writeup.html – make sure it points to existing results

Compressing to .zip file

- Windows
 - Right-click the root folder, point to **Send To**, and then click **Compressed (zipped) Folder**
 - Mac and Linux
- ```
zip -9 -r studentID_cos426_assignmentX.zip studentID_cos426_assignmentX
```

# Not sure? Verify!

1. Unzip your zip file
  - Mac/Linux: `unzip studentID_cos426_assignment1.zip`
  - Windows: right-click the folder, click **Extract All**, and then follow the instructions
2. Build the project
  - Windows: Open `.sln` file and run **Build**
  - Mac/Linux:
    - `cd studentID_cos426_assignment1/src`
    - `make`
    - `cd ..`
3. Reassemble the output folder
  - Windows:
    - delete output folder
    - run `nmake /f Nmakefile`
  - Mac/Linux:
    - `make clean`
    - `make all`
